## What do we need to bring?

First, you will need to hire a car.

Although it's perfectly possible to walk to the village shop and to the local bars, this is a country house and for all practical purposes, you'll need transport.

You'll need to bring beach towels.

All household and bedlinen is provided, but towels for the beach and poolside get extra wear and tear, not to mention sunscreen, so please bring your own. There is a washing machine to launder them.

Bring a laptop. The connection is in the sitting room downstairs and there is a wi-fi connection.

Bring your music - there's a dock for an iPod - and DVDs.

There's a CD player and a DVD player and of course a small collection of movies.

## What's already there?

In the kitchen: cooker, microwave, refrigerator, freezer (in store-room next door), dishwasher, food-processor, cooking utensils and otherwise fully equipped. There is a long refectory table seating 12 and an open fireplace with a removable grill. (This also fits the built barbecue on the terrace outside).

Generally good mobile phone coverage, depending on your network.

Wood burning stoves in the patio and salon, and electric radiators and gas heaters for winter heating. Electric blankets.

No air conditioning (it's a 19<sup>th</sup> century farmhouse and it's up in the hills!) but electric fans, if needed.

For infants: 2 cots, and a high-chair. There is a small room off the south bedroom suitable for an infant.

A hair-dryer and plenty of adaptor plugs (UK into continental).
